San Leandro City Council, Residents and City Employees –

With great sadness, the City received word that Eden Health District Director Charles Gilcrest passed away on August 3rd due to complications from a heart attack. A lifelong resident of San Leandro, Gilcrest was engaged in community affairs his entire adult life and possessed an encyclopedic knowledge of San Leandro's history. Among the positions Gilcrest held were President of the Business Association of South San Leandro (BASSL) and of the Halcyon Foothill Neighborhood Association, Chair of the Joint Project Area Redevelopment Advisory Committee and of the Board of Zoning Adjustments, and a member of the City's Human Services Commission. Mayor Cutter declared November 7, 2018, as "Charles Gilcrest Day" in the city, observing "Charlie has mentored and guided both aspiring and veteran political leaders and continues to be a loyal, beloved friend and community advocate who ardently dedicates himself to San Leandro."



As previously announced on August 1<sup>st</sup>, the City of San Leandro is also now seeking 28 members of the community (residents, business representatives, City employees) to form the Community Advisory Budget Task Force. The purpose of this task force is to provide budget-related recommendations to the City Council.

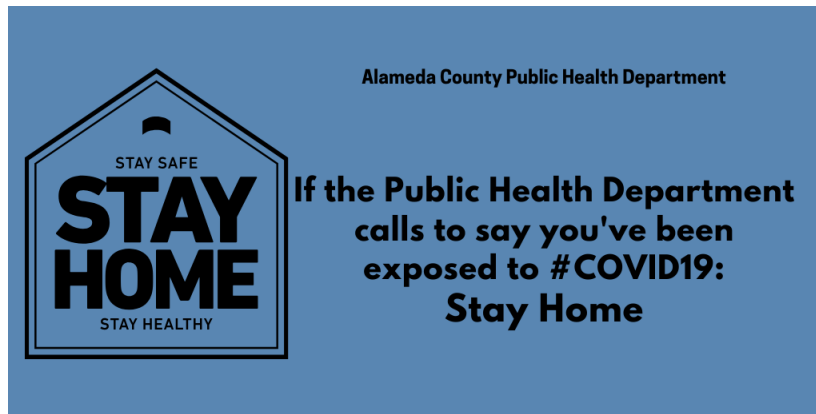
