### San Leandro Receives Third KaBoom! Playground Grant (Attached)

In partnership with Alameda County Firefighters Local 55, San Leandro Police Officers Association and Kaiser Permanente, the City of San Leandro will make improvements to Washington Manor Park through a grant from KaBoom!, a national nonprofit dedicated to giving kids the childhood they deserve by bringing play to those who need it most. The project kicks off with a design session on Tuesday June 13<sup>th</sup> and "Build Day" is scheduled for Saturday, August 5<sup>th</sup>.
