Sally Barros, the City's Sustainability Manager was featured in several events where she highlighted the City's sustainability and smart city efforts. Please see a description of her two most recent presentations:

- **State Energy Efficiency Collaborative:** San Leandro was joined by the Cities of San Diego and Chula Vista to present real-world case studies that highlight smart city projects with a focus on vendor engagement strategies for energy efficiency projects. Ms. Barros showcased San Leandro's Smart City initiatives as well as our approach to grid-enabled smart LED street lights.
- **Climate Fundamentals Academies of the Association of Climate Change Officers:** Held at Stanford University, the City of San Leandro presented on two occasions the development of the City's Climate Action Plan and its implementation as well as the recent completion of the carbon emissions inventory.
