Taste of San Leandro

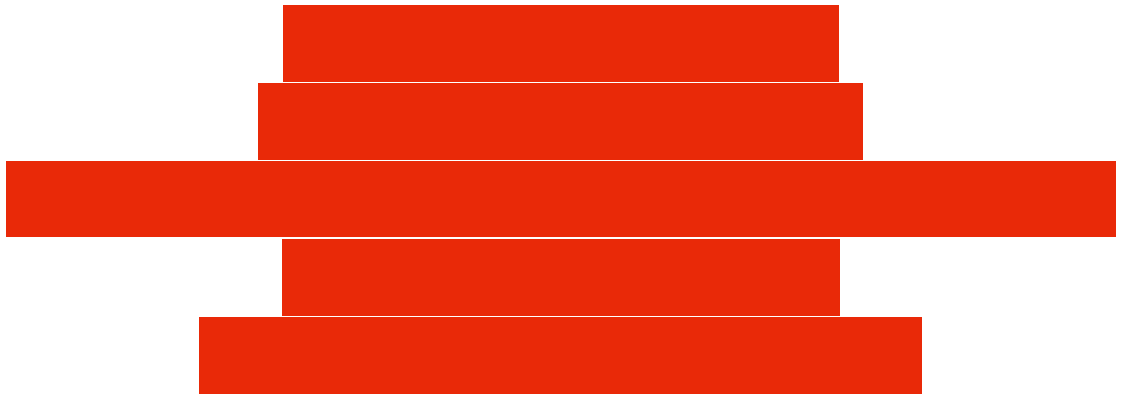

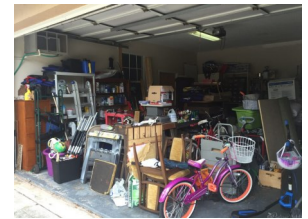
