San Leandro Creek Trail Master Plan Update

The San Leandro Creek Trail Master Plan received [\\$4.1 million in funding](#) from the California Natural Resources Agency for planting of trees and construction of a trail and bridges connecting 105th Avenue and Madison School to the Martin Luther King Jr Shoreline at Hegenberger Road. While the funding is for a portion of the creek trail in the City of Oakland, not San Leandro, it shows the value of the plan. Staff is current working on a technical assistance grant through ABAG to fund the necessary environmental assessment work and develop technical plans for the portion of the creek trail in San Leandro from Alvarado Street west to the railroad tracks. Code Enforcement Focuses Efforts on Unpermitted Signage on the City's Major Corridors

In October of this year, the City's new Code Enforcement team began proactive enforcement of the City's Zoning Code (Section 4-1806 (L)) which prohibits banners, balloons, waving flags and A-Frame signage. Staff visited businesses along East 14th Street, Davis Street and Marina Boulevard to introduce themselves, provide information regarding the City's sign regulations, request unpermitted signs be removed and advise the businesses that enforcement of the City's sign regulations would begin in two weeks. The majority of the signs have been removed which improves the appearance of the streets and visibility of store fronts. To date, six Courtesy Notices of Violation have been issued and two business have come to the office to begin the process of obtaining permanent mounted signage. The Code Enforcement team is expanding their efforts to include Washington Avenue, Doolittle Drive and MacArthur Boulevard in the coming weeks. A press release was issued on November 22, 2017 to share this information with the public and provide an overview of the City's regulations on blight.
