America Recycles Update

The Recycling Program, housed in the Public Works Department hosted “America Recycles Day” on November 14. It is an annual event dedicated to encouraging residents to recycle and raise awareness about the importance of recycling every day. Over 350 residents participated and stated that the materials would have ended up in the trash without this opportunity. Staff accepted over 2,900 pounds of recycling including:

- 450 pounds of pharmaceuticals,
- 845 pounds of batteries,
- 503 pounds of fluorescent lights,
- 303 pounds of incandescent light bulbs, and
- 836 pounds of electronic media (CDs, DVDs, audio and video cassettes)

Downtown Parking Management Plan Update

Since the adoption of the Downtown San Leandro Parking Management Plan in 2017, City staff is actively working with parking consultant *Dixon Resources Unlimited* to transform the San Leandro parking experience. Efforts include updating the Police Department parking enforcement technology and a park meters that can be paid via an app on your smartphone. Through an RFP process, *Parkmobile* was selected as the vendor for a mobile payment option for parking. The service will be rolled out in January. Outreach for the transition include an information booth at the “It’s a Wonderful Night” event on Dec. 1st and leveraging upcoming community events to inform the public on how to register and take advantage of the program. *Parkmobile* allows for residents and visitors to pay for their parking with their smart phones via an app, in addition to paying parking meters with coins. Parkmobile provides similar mobile payment services in our neighboring communities including Oakland, Berkeley and Walnut Creek.
