Holiday Lights Recycling Program Update

The Department of Public Works completed its second annual Holiday Lights Recycling Program. Over the seven-week program, over 80 residents dropped off over 1,100 pounds of stringed lighting, representing a 400 percent increase from the prior year. Participants expressed their appreciation for the program and added that had the program not been in place, their unused and broken lights would be in the landfill.
