AC Transit – Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) Project – Tree Removal Advisory

BRT project construction is now underway, including roadway widening to make room for new artistically-designed boarding platforms. AC Transit announced that due to the upcoming bird nesting season, tree removals began this week. When construction is completed, the BRT project will plant 285 new trees. At some locations the tree replanting represents a 1-for-1 ratio and in others, replanting will occur on a 3-to-1 ratio. 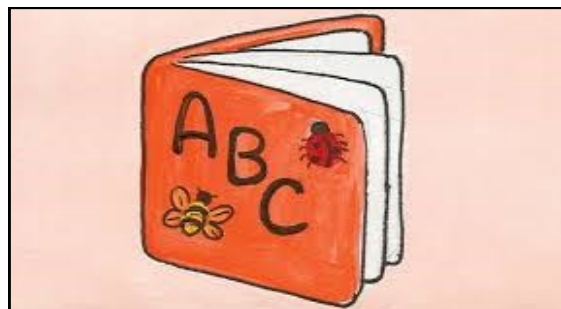
