Fall Leaf Bag Program

October 2, 2016 — January 13, 2017

Excess leaves fill sidewalks and streets, clog storm drains and harbor pests. Collect and recycle excess leaves that don't fit in your green waste cart. *Bags are collected curbside on your regular collection day through January 29, 2017.* Leaves placed in plastic garbage bags will not be collected. Maximum 15 bags per San Leandro household. Last day to pick up bags is January 13, 2017.

Holiday Tree Recycling Program

January 1, 2017 — January 13, 2017



Alameda County Industries (ACI) and Waste Management of Alameda County (WMAC) will collect your holiday tree, at no additional charge, for composting during the first two weeks of January. Place your tree on the curb on your scheduled collection day. Remove all decorations, lights and the stand. The tree should be cut in half, if it is taller than 6 feet. Flocked and artificial trees cannot be composted, place them in the garbage, or schedule a special collection with your provider.

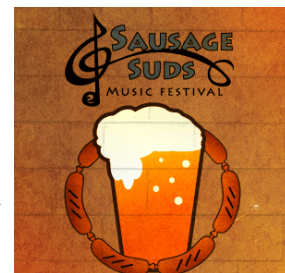
