This is the first of 14 public meetings to solicit community feedback and is open to the general public.

**San Leandro Police to Host REACH OUT Youth Summit on Saturday November 7<sup>th</sup>**

The San Leandro Police Department will be sponsoring the REACH OUT Youth Summit on Saturday, November 7<sup>th</sup> from 12:00 noon – 4 p.m. at the REACH Ashland Youth Center. The summit welcomes youth between the ages of 14-20. The goal of the event is to interact positively with young people regarding gang and youth violence prevention in a fun and supportive atmosphere, and to connect them with resources and services.

The event will kick off with music and a hosted lunch. The program will feature Daniel Mora as the keynote speaker and the youth will enjoy a variety of breakout sessions that include: college and career readiness, violence prevention, leadership development and a community building session where students will have the opportunity to meet community leaders. The summit will conclude with a musical performance, snacks and personal interaction with grant team members and resources.

The Summit is part of the anti-violence efforts funded by the two-year Cal GRIP grant that the Police Department received in 2013. Over the past two years, the grant has funded a variety of activities and services provided by the Cal GRIP team members – including the REACH Ashland Youth Center, Deputy Sheriff’s Activities League, Alameda County Arts Commission, Soulciety, and the San Lorenzo and San Leandro Unified School Districts.
