MEASURE VV

Measure VV Ballot Question:

“To maintain City of San Leandro services, with revenue that cannot be taken by the State, including: repairing potholes/streets; supporting seniors, families and local small businesses through COVID-19 economic recovery; preserving 911 emergency response; maintaining youth violence prevention programs; and general city services; shall San Leandro increase the existing real property transfer tax rate, collected when property is sold, by \$5 per \$1,000 in valuation, generating an additional \$4,000,000 annually, until repealed by voters, all funds benefiting San Leandro?”

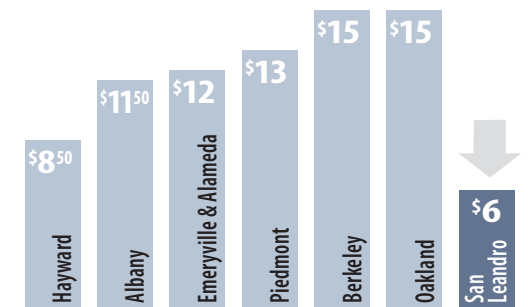

Measure VV Defined:

Measure VV is a local ballot measure sponsored by the City of San Leandro in the November 3rd Presidential Election. Measure VV seeks voter authorization to maintain San Leandro city services by adjusting the City’s existing Real Property Transfer Tax (RPTT) by \$5 per \$1,000 of property value. Measure VV requires a simple majority (50%+) to pass. A “YES vote” approves funding for the measure to maintain city services; a “NO vote” rejects the measure. All City of San Leandro registered voters will be able to vote on Measure VV.

RPTT Defined:

The RPTT is a one-time tax collected upon the purchase of real estate, including residential or commercial property. Local governments use RPTT revenue to fund critical local public services. The RPTT is collected only when real estate is bought or sold. San Leandro currently has the lowest RPTT rate among eligible cities in Alameda County.



Current Alameda County RPTT Rates*

* Oakland rate: properties sold for \$300,001 to \$2 million.
Berkeley rate: properties sold under \$1.5 million.

YOU HAVE 3 OPTIONS:

1. VOTE BY MAIL

In response to COVID-19, the California Governor's Office mandated that EVERY registered voter will receive a **VOTE-BY-MAIL** ballot for the November 3rd election. Returning your ballot via US Mail is easy, convenient, and simple.

- ▶ **NO POSTAGE NECESSARY!**
- ▶ **Complete and mail in your ballot EARLY** to ensure it will be among the first to be counted.
- ▶ Tracking the status of your mail ballot is now easier. Alameda County uses "BallotTrax" to let voters know the status of their ballots. Sign up at www.acvote.ballottrax.net to receive automatic email or text notifications on the status of your ballot.

2. DROP OFF YOUR BALLOT

DROP YOUR BALLOT AT AN OFFICIAL 24-HOUR DROP BOX.
