NEW BUSINESS

Chief Torres:

- Acting City Manager Fran Robustelli will be discussing the Police Chief Recruitment with the Board. Executive Recruiter Teri Black will be in attendance.

- **Youth Advisory Board:**

 - Group met to discuss the formation of a Chief's Youth Advisory Board

 - Possible GPA requirements (comparable to athletic requirements)
