## 15<sup>th</sup> Downtown San Leandro Farmers' Market to Open in New Location

SAN LEANDRO, CA – The popular [Downtown San Leandro Farmers' Market](#) returns for its 15<sup>th</sup> season on Wednesday, April 6, from 3:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. The City of San Leandro is excited to announce that this year the market is moving to a new home at the Main Library parking lot at 300 Estudillo Avenue.

The Downtown San Leandro Farmers' Market hosts an average of 2,500 patrons weekly. Community members have found the market to be a great place to meet family and friends, and enjoy live music, fantastic food and family-friendly entertainment. The seasonal market will occur weekly on Wednesdays from 3:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. through October 5, 2022.

This year, to celebrate the 15<sup>th</sup> year of the Downtown San Leandro Farmers' Market, as well as the City of San Leandro's sesquicentennial (150<sup>th</sup> year) milestone, the opening market will feature live music by [Hella Fitzgerald](#) and a raffle for chances to win one of three [Keeping It Local San Leandro virtual gift cards](#). The event will kick off with an opening ceremony at 5:30PM on April 6, featuring remarks from Mayor Pauline Cutter and City Manager Frances Robustelli.



There will be up to 30 vendors at the 2022 Farmers' Market, including San Leandro's [Hummus Heaven](#). Popular vendors [Jaden's Kettle Corn](#), [Double R Honey Farms](#), [Stueve Organic Family Farms](#), Lemus Farms, [Bunbao](#), [Roli Roti](#), [Sunrise Nursery](#), [J&M Farms](#), and [the Fruit Tree](#) will be returning to the market, among several others. Live music will return on a weekly basis, this year coordinated by the [Pacific Coast Farmers' Market Association](#) in collaboration with the San Leandro Library.

Free parking for the new location will be available on the first and fourth floors of the Downtown Parking Garage starting at 3PM on Wednesdays during the market season. The garage is located at 122 Estudillo Avenue and may be accessed from either Callan or Estudillo Avenues. (Visit [www.parks1.com](http://www.parks1.com) for more information). There is also ample street parking on both Callan Street and Estudillo Avenue, adjacent to the Library parking lot. Entry to the Library parking lot will be closed on Callan Street, and partially closed on Santa Rosa Street. The entry on Estudillo Avenue will remain open.
