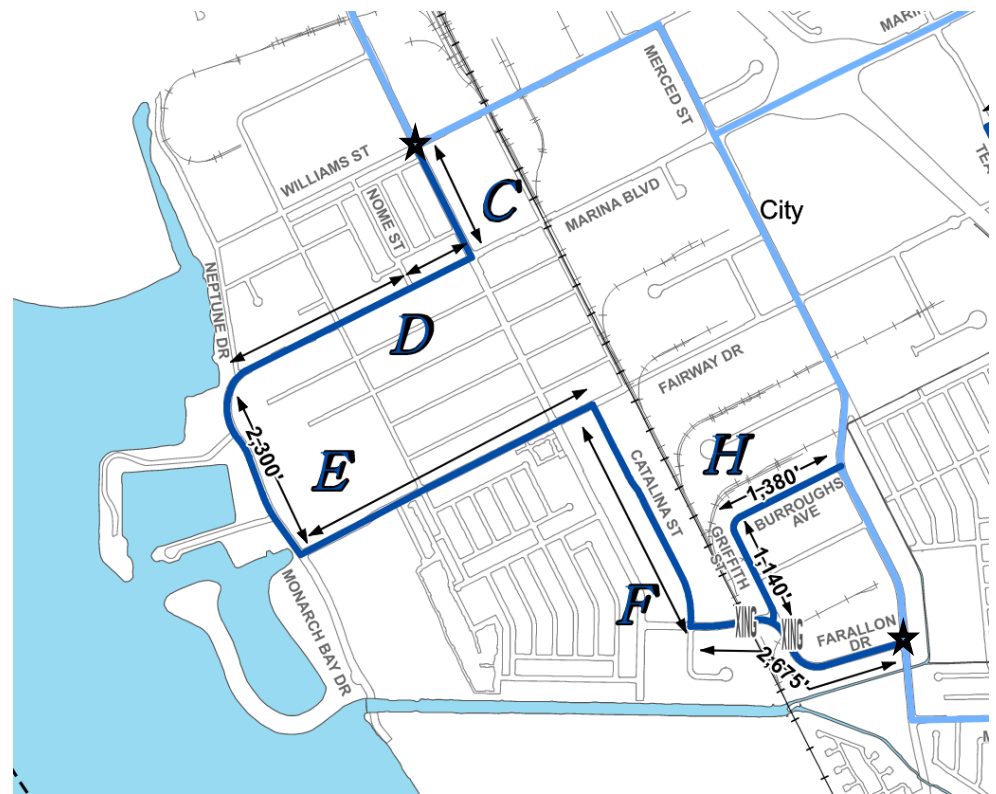


SAN LEANDRO PLANS TO EXPAND FIBER OPTIC NETWORK

The City of San Leandro is proud to announce the expansion of the fiber optic network. The project is in its design phase with an estimated half a million dollar budget. The expansion will start from the intersection of Williams Street and Doolittle Drive, and proceed around the shoreline to connect at existing facilities on Wicks Boulevard. See image on right, sections C, D, E, F.

The project is in the second phase of our 2013 “Fiber Conduit For Broadband Network Project”. As an addition, traffic signals will be incorporated into the fiber loop along Doolittle Drive at Marina Boulevard and Fairway Drive.



Sections C,D,E,F encompasses where fiber optic cable will be installed.

The project funds are provided by the America Rescue Plan Act (ARPA), which aim to provide communities access to high speed broadband as it aids members in the community in tasks such as accessing essential services, job searches, homework, and much more. The ARPA funds will also be used to find existing issues in our fiber network throughout San Leandro.

This project is expected to be in construction by summer of 2023.
